

Thank You for Visiting Male Expressions

Enjoy your free phone wallpaper download—created to look great on modern iPhone and Android devices. Below are simple steps to unzip, pick the right file, and set your wallpaper in seconds.

What's Inside Your Download

- A single ZIP containing two folders:
 - iPhone/ — optimized JPGs including 15/16/17 and Pro Max-friendly sizes (pinch-to-zoom supported).
 - Android/ — a widely compatible FHD+ 20:9 JPG (1080×2400).

Quick Start — iPhone

1. Download the ZIP to your iPhone (via Safari/Chrome).
2. Open the Files app → Downloads → tap the ZIP to extract.
3. Open the iPhone folder and tap a wallpaper to view it.
4. Tap the Share icon → “Use as Wallpaper” (or Add to Photos, then set via Photos).
5. Pinch/zoom to taste, keeping key details clear of the Dynamic Island and the bottom home bar. In IOS 26, press the clock and hold. Choose the 2nd clock option so image will not drag the clock as you pinch and zoom.
6. Tap Add → choose Lock Screen, Home Screen, or Both.

iPhone Tips

- For iPhone 17/17 Pro, choose 1206×2622; for 17 Pro Max, use 1320×2868. Both also works on 15/16 models.
- If the “Depth”/“Perspective” effect shifts the image too much, turn it off for tighter control.
- Leave a little breathing room at the top/bottom so icons and the clock don’t cover important details.

Quick Start — Android

1. Download the ZIP to your phone.
2. Open Files (or My Files) → Downloads → tap the ZIP to extract.

3. Open the Android folder and tap the wallpaper to open it.
4. Tap the overflow menu (⋮) → “Set as wallpaper” (wording varies by device).
5. Choose Lock Screen, Home Screen, or both. Adjust crop if prompted.

Android Tips

- The included 1080×2400 file matches common FHD+ 20:9 screens and scales cleanly on many devices.
- On Samsung (One UI): long-press Home screen → Wallpaper & style → Gallery → pick the image.
- On Pixel: long-press Home screen → Wallpaper & style → Photos → choose the image.
- If your phone is QHD+ (1440p) and you want extra crispness, reach out—happy to provide a larger export.

Troubleshooting

ZIP won’t open: Update iOS/Android and use the built-in Files app. As a fallback, try a free unzip app.

Image looks cropped: Use pinch/zoom while setting the wallpaper, or disable Depth/Perspective effects.

Icons cover the face: Try the Pro Max size or nudge the image slightly downward before applying.
